Database

Vendors:	Microsoft Oracle Sybase
Database server(s)	Microsoft SQL Server 2005 (32bit) or (64bit) Microsoft SQL Server 2008 (32bit) or (64bit) Oracle 10g Oracle 11g Sybase 9 ,10 and 11

The SuperOffice database can run on existing database servers (stand-alone or clustered)

Server

Server Operating System:	Microsoft Windows Server 2003 (32bit) or (64bit) Microsoft Windows Server 2008 (32bit) or (64bit)
Document Archive:	File share on a server to store documents and e-mails archived in SuperOffice
Protocol:	File share uses standard SMB port 445
Distribution:	All client files (MSI) are installed on the server along with the database configuration tool dbsetup.exe
Disk space:	250MB for Client files with all languages 1GB document archive*

Note!

The SuperOffice server is now only used for hosting the client files and document archive.
There will not be any SuperOffice installation on this server.

*The size of the document archive will vary depending on the amount of users and documents created from SuperOffice. Size the disk space according to your own business needs
